

HOT LUNCH REMINDERS

- *Each hot lunch costs \$3.50, which includes one milk. Each additional milk for hot lunch or milk for a sack lunch costs \$.40 each.*
- Each family has only one lunch account which includes all students in the family. Payments for all family members' meals and lunches can be made in any amount at any time.
- *Lunches and milks should be pay for in advance.* We can accept cash or checks, however it is best to put your lunch money in an envelope if you are sending cash. Your child should then turn this in to his/her teacher. You can write one check for all of your children.
- Two counts will be taken each morning in order for us to get an accurate count of the number of lunches needed for each day and an estimate for the next day. Your child's teacher will ask each morning what he/she will be eating - the first hot lunch option, the second hot lunch option or sack lunch - for today and tomorrow. Please make sure your child knows which he/she will be having for each day.
- If your child will be gone during lunch for an appointment, etc. or brought to school after school begins, please remind him/her not to order hot lunch for that day. *If we order a lunch for your child, we are charged for it whether he or she eats it or not. Therefore, we also have to charge you. We are also still charged at full price for free and reduced price lunches.*
- If your child goes home sick, you will not be charged for that lunch.
- Any unused lunch balance is always carried over to the next week and into the next school year.
- Parents are always welcome to eat lunch with their child(ren). Call the office by 8:00 AM if you wish to order a lunch. Adult lunches cost \$4.15 with or without milk.
- Information about your families lunch account is available through your Skyward account after signing on with your unique user name and password. The balance reflects all members of your family. - Printed menus are no longer sent home, since the online version can show all nutritional information. A current menu can be accessed through the school's website as well as at the Holmen School District website. You can print one or get a printed one in the office if necessary.
- You may complete an application for free or reduced lunches at any time. The general guidelines are on the form, which is on the school website or in the office.
